The Foundation provides her with food, clothes, medical and clinical services and all of her schooling needs, including tuition, school uniform, books and school supplies. Currently she is in Standard six at Ukombozi Primary School. Agnes is doing very well in school, and after school she likes playing netball, reading books and singing, and helps with kitchen work. She also has a special place in her heart for the younger orphans. She sleeps in the same room with the toddlers and babies so she can help them at night. Agnes wishes to become a Lawyer.
