EDGAR was born in Songea. His father passed away in 2007 leaving him and his three brothers with their mother. His mother found it very difficult to raise the children alone because she had no employment because of little education and there were no other resources. Cultivating with bare hands without machinery and being unable to afford fertilizers and insecticides earned very little to provide the bare necessities of life, let alone the education of the children. Edgar was forced to help his mother by begging and doing menial jobs whose earnings didn't amount to much at all. The family problems were growing daily and causing anxiety and frustration particularly when it comes to the high costs of the children's education.

Edgar's mother decided to find assistance from SWACCO, the local organization which works with Mwangaza Jitegemee Foundation. SWACCO considered the pleadings of the mother to be real and

urgent and took Edgar in the orphanage in 2008. Edgar is provided with food, clothes, shoes, medical and clinical aid, school fees, other school contributions, and school equipments. Edgar is going to school without worries and likes his studies. Currently he is in Form IV in Secondary School. During his spare time he likes sports especially soccer. Edgar has a long walk in his education, and SWACCO will see to it that he reaches that destination.
