

Fadhili was born in May 02, 1999 in Songea. He has a sister and two brothers. Both parents passed away in 2003 leaving behind the four children with their very old grandparents who were not able to work to earn money to support the children in their day to day needs and especially in their education. They felt additional stress because Fadhili suffered from poor health occasionally. That was too much for the grandfather to carry such a burden in such a poor situation. He insisted they find another solution; they could no longer care for the children. The three older children left to find other places on their own. The grandfather decided to find help for Fadhili from SWACCO, the Songean Women and Children's Care Organization, a local organization which works with the Mwangaza Jitigeme Foundation. Fadhili was admitted to the SWACCO temporary orphanage in 2004.

Fadhili is very happy to be at the orphanage. He is comfortable with his companions and he does not worry about his living condition. He goes to school and he is in Standard V at Ukombozi Primary School. Fadhili is doing fairly well in school, but his health is sometimes not very good; but Fadhili works very hard to succeed. To energize himself he likes all sports, soccer is his favorite. When back

from school helps in gardening, pruning the orange and banana plants in the garden is his favorite task. He is very happy that there is a young dog to play with. He says that he wants to be strong because he wants one day to be a soldier. SWACCO pledges to help him to reach the goal of his choice.
