She finally decided to find help from SWACCO, the local organization which works with the Mwangaza Jitegemee Foundation. Once they were able, in 2006 SWACCO accepted Fulko into their program.

The Foundation provides Fulko with food, clothes, shoes and medical and clinical services. In addition to the above, MJF covers all of his schooling needs, including tuition, school uniform, books and school supplies. Currently Fulko's life is flourishing. He enjoys going to a very good school and he completed Form IV in November, 2011 at De -Paul Secondary School. Fulko is anxious to go on with his studies that will award him with a good

profession that will benefit his future life and the community. He dreams of being a pilot. He is so thankful for the generosity of SWACCO, MJF and the sponsors, he says that he had no hope for so long and now he has lots of it.
